
DRUM TYPES B






Standard Crimped drums make up 90+% of all drums made. They are less expensive and do their designed task well. They do not handle heat well. The expansion and contraction causes the seaming compound to leak prematurely. When shopping for drums, unless specifically stated otherwise, it's safe to assume the drum is of this type.


Bubba's Barrels does not use this type of drum for building kettles.
